

All Hawaii winners at a glance

As first winner of the Ironman Hawaii, the US marine officer Gordon Haller wrote sportive history in 1978 - on the Hawaiian island Oahu. But who is talking today of the first female winner? Lyn Lemaire, also US American, remained tightly below 13 hours; after that, not much more has been heard of the first Ironwoman in Hawaii. Remarkable also: only after 16 years, in October 1994, the Australian Greg Welch could break the US-American predominance at the Ironman Hawaii in Kona.
